Legacy Preparatory Charter Academy offers career and technical programs in Health Science, Information Technology, Business Management, and STEM. During their 8th grade school year, all scholars are presented with information regarding their options. Admission to all CTE courses is based on scholars' pathway selection supported by parent consultation. All Legacy scholars in grades 9-11 are enrolled in CTE courses.
