



Child Find Notice

Legacy Preparatory Charter Academy (LPCA) is responsible for identifying, locating, and evaluating children from birth to 21 years of age with known or suspected disabilities who reside in and/or attend school within the school district's boundaries. Child Find is a free referral service designed to determine whether a need for special education and related services exists.

Referral Process

A referral to Child Find may be made by any person concerned about a child's development including:

- Parents
- Teachers
- Administrators
- Daycare Providers
- Physicians
- Outside agencies, therapists, Early Childhood Intervention (ECI)

ECI provides services to children with disabilities from birth to the age of 3. Students receiving services through ECI will be transitioned into the public school system prior to their third birthday.
